We will be able to go deep into the **different dimensions** of cannabis and its evolution through lectures and **open forums** organized in themes.

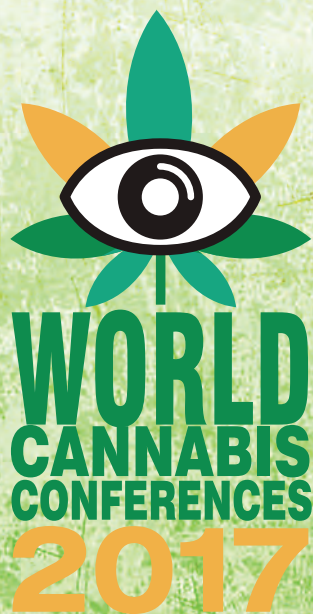

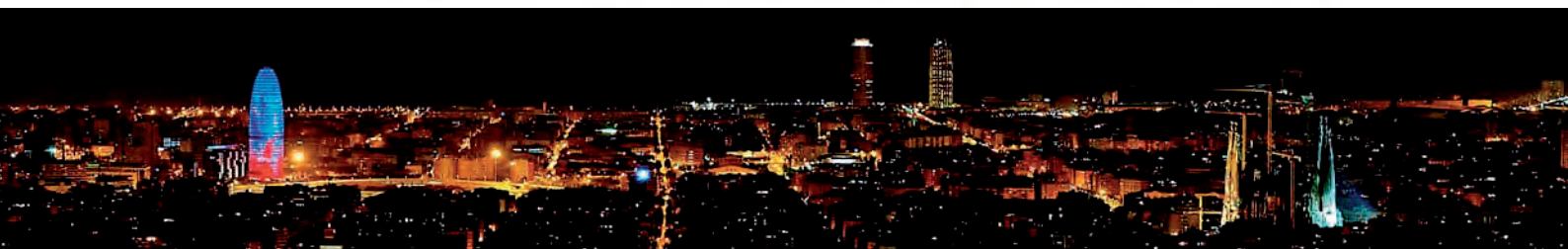

Legal Cannabis Social Clubs

Héctor Brotons Albert. Principal of Brotsanbert Legal Study. Law Degree from the Alicante University and graduate in the Legal Practice School of the Alicante's Bar Association. Criminal Law and Public Health specialist. He advises Cannabis Social Clubs all over Spain. Law advisor at FAC (Federación de Asociaciones Cannábicas) (Federation of Cannabis Associations) and other platforms. He writes articles and gives speeches at diverse forums. He has advocated more than a thousand of cannabis-related cases, also counseling foreign lawyers.



On the present conference, Héctor Brotons will analyze the latest Supreme Court's decisions related to Cannabis Social Clubs (CSC), through the lens of fundamental rights recognized on the Spanish Constitution and international texts in this regard. This question played a crucial part on the appeal for legal protection against the sentence condemning the original Pannagh Association, on which the lecturer directed a multidisciplinary group, and where it makes patently clear that due to Public Health and to the texts quoted, those CSC fulfilling determined requirements can't be condemned.

Spanish Medicinal Cannabis Observatory

The Spanish Medicinal Cannabis Observatory (OECM) is born in October 2015 with the need to promote, coordinate and develop activities and projects oriented to improve the knowledge about properties and medicinal uses of cannabis and its derivatives. Furthermore, it aims to advise public and private entities and inform the institutions, media and civil society about cannabis knowledge current situation, based on the results of scientific research and clinical trials.



Guillermo Velasco. Guillermo Velasco is PhD in Biology by the Complutense University of Madrid, where he is currently professor of the Biochemistry and Molecular Biology Department I. The main line of investigation of the team coordinated by Guillermo Velasco heads towards the development and optimization of antitumor therapies based on the use of cannabinoids.



Carola Pérez. Carola Pérez is graduate in Audiovisual Communication, and has dedicated the greater part of her professional career to this field. She currently presides the Spanish Medicinal Cannabis Observatory (OECM), and is the founder of Dosemociones (Two emotions), an association of therapeutic users, where she gives advice and support to all the patients using cannabis with medical purposes.
